

PHASE 2 REPORT

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR THE PAMC REVIEW PROJECT

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May 31, 2021



INTRODUCTION

Following the initial Phase 1 audit of the Port Angeles Municipal Code (“PAMC”), we embarked on Phase 2 of the municipal code review project. Phase 2 involved the following tasks:

- City Council and staff review and evaluation of the Phase 1 PAMC Audit Final Report; and
- Formulation of a Phase 3 Implementation Plan that includes a determination on:
 - Priorities;
 - Timeline;
 - Budget; and
 - Other elements, as developed from the analysis of the audit.

At the City Council meeting on May 18, 2021, we reviewed the proposed Phase 3 recommendations for the Council’s input. The following pages include a summary of our recommendations for Phase 3 implementation based on the Council’s feedback.

PHASE 3 RECOMMENDATIONS

To formulate our Phase 3 recommendations, we solicited written and verbal feedback from the City Council and City staff. Using this information and our professional expertise, we have developed the following proposed Phase 3 Implementation Plan.

DRAFTING

Drafting amendments to an entire municipal code is a daunting and time-consuming task. Because of the breadth of subject matters, if City staff were to undertake this task, it would likely require numerous staff members and hours to do so. However, City staff have expressed concern over the amount of staff time required to do this work, which would heavily eat into their time to accomplish other tasks. As everyone has acknowledged throughout this process, there is a desire to move this project along as quickly as possible, and if staff (or even the Council) were to be tasked with undertaking the initial drafting, there would likely be additional significant delays.

In addition, one of the goals with this project is to provide uniformity and cohesiveness. Utilizing a variety of drafters, each with their separate styles and voice, will increase the chances the code does not have the uniformity of language sought.

For these reasons, we recommend that Madrona Law Group (“Madrona”) undertake the task of the initial drafting of amendments. Madrona will primarily utilize Ann Marie Soto and Rachel Turpin for drafting, as Ann Marie and Rachel have been the leads on this project. We will, however, utilize supplemental assistance from other Madrona members with expertise in particular areas. For example, Kim Adams Pratt, an experienced environmental and land use practitioner who has litigated countless land use cases, will assist with drafting amendments to Title 15. Eileen Keiffer, a highly regarded expert in Utilities and Telecommunications, will assist in updates to Titles 11 and 13.

While Madrona will take the laboring oar, drafting the amendments will still be a collaborative process—after all, this is *Port Angeles’s* code. We will work closely with City staff and Council to incorporate their feedback and suggestions into the draft, while at the same time including our recommendations to the City. Once an initial draft is prepared, drafts will be circulated to City staff for review and input, then forwarded onto the Council for review, discussion, public comment, and, ultimately, adoption.

PRIORITIES

We discussed two different primary approaches to tackling the code update: a wholesale rewrite and piecemeal amendments. Although a wholesale rewrite could have many benefits, such as ensuring consistency, avoiding creating conflicts between codes, etc., Council and staff recognize the need to address certain items sooner rather than later and have expressed concern that a wholesale rewrite will take much longer to complete—and may never get done. Further, budgetary constraints may impact the amount and timing of amendments to be made. As a result, we recommend the City address the code update through a piecemeal process, tackling amendments by subject matter in order of priority.

We solicited feedback regarding the priorities by topic. Feedback ranged from addressing specific subject matters to addressing conflicts within the code and also to addressing the “low hanging fruit,” meaning those items that can be quickly checked off to keep the project moving. Based on the feedback received, we recommend a combination of approaches—first, addressing the high priority subjects, then addressing the remaining topics by title. The following is a proposed list of priorities by topic/subject matter:

- Fee Schedule and related provisions in Title 3¹
- Code Enforcement (including updates to penalties) and Titles 1 and 8
- Regulating short term rentals (can be added as a new chapter in Title 5 or incorporated into the Development code as part of Maker’s work)
- Updating business license provisions and/or transitioning to a general business license approach and Title 5
- Updating criminal code and Title 9
- Updating code relating to boards and commissions
- Adopting/updating special event code (can be added as a new chapter in Title 5)
- Title 11 – Streets and Sidewalks
- Title 12 – Public Places
- Title 10 – Vehicles and Traffic
- Title 13 - Utilities
- Title 7 - Animals
- Title 2 (may include some overlap with Maker’s work)
- Remainder of Title 3 – Revenue and Finance
- Title 4 – Public Corporations
- Titles 15 and 18 (to be coordinated with Maker’s work)

These priorities are not set in stone and can be shifted around as needs or desires change. In addition, it may make sense to move items around based on the timing of work being performed by Maker’s. Ideally, multiple topics will be worked on at the same time to keep the project moving along at a swift pace.

¹ This item involves reorganization, only, not an update to the fees, which should be done after undertaking a fee study.

SOLICITING FEEDBACK FROM STAKEHOLDERS

Various ideas were discussed for receiving feedback and policy direction from stakeholders, such as the City Councilmembers, City staff, and members of the public. What may work for some individuals, however, may not work for others. For example, some individuals would prefer to provide feedback and comments in writing, while others may be more inclined to comment in person at public meetings or open houses. Thus, we recommend the City utilize a variety of options in an effort to cast a wide net. Options include:

- One-on-one meetings with Councilmembers
- Public open house kick-off meeting
- Resident/business owner surveys²
- Special Council workshops by topic, such as:³
 - Code enforcement
 - Business licensing
 - Short term rentals
 - Animals
 - Public Places and Special Events
- Written feedback soliciting throughout the project.

Keep in mind, even with utilizing multiple methods, however, the City may still only receive feedback from a small subset of the City's population and business community. By offering numerous opportunities to provide feedback, the City will increase the chances of obtaining valuable comments from all of the City's stakeholders.

PROPOSED SCHEDULE

A complete overhaul of the PAMC will take some time. However, this project has been a long time coming and has momentum. To keep the momentum going, we propose an aggressive schedule as we embark on this process as follows:

- One-on-one meetings with council early in **June/July**
- Open House/send out surveys **by mid-July**
- Council workshop on code enforcement in **August**

² While Madrona will assist with drafting the survey questions and analyzing the survey results, we recommend the City conduct the survey(s), either in-house or with the help of a surveying/market research consultant.

³ These topics were identified as subjects that would likely result in significant input from the public, or that may require additional policy direction from the City Council.

- Endeavor to address “low hanging fruit” and high priority in front of the Council **late-summer/early fall**⁴
- Rollout remaining chapters/titles as ready
- Quarterly check-ins with Council (either in writing or in person)
- Final clean-up to address conflicts resulting from the code update.

Some topics and titles will take less time and effort than others; thus, as previously explained, we will be simultaneously working on multiple titles at the same time. As we go through this process, certain subjects may require greater time and resources. Ultimately, we will work through each subject and title from drafting through adoption.

⁴ This would specifically encompass the fee schedule and related amendments, code enforcement, and Titles 1 and 8.


CONCLUSION





Q3 If you never looked at the PAMC before today, why not?



Q4 Discharge of fireworks is currently banned within the City. How important is it to provide the Police Department with additional enforcement tools to enforce this ban to the fullest?




















