The competition will include participants of all ages who will be here to compete in this Gold Cup Northwest Series and will be presented by DK Bikes. We are honored to be hosting an event that will have many local qualifiers for the finals line up and is expected to bring a total of 2,000 racers for three days of racing with an expected attendance of 6,000-7,000 people to Port Angeles. Our community has had great success with hosting events such as the Big Hurt, North West Cup, North Olympic Discovery Marathon, and Ride the Hurricane. These events and the success of Lincoln Park BMX went a long way towards our ability to compete with other towns to win the bid for this race.
