Generation II Dream Playground Equipment is Here!

The Generation II Dream Playground equipment has officially arrived in Port Angeles. On December 14, 2020, City Parks & Recreation staff unloaded the delivery of playground equipment, which will be stored until later next year. The equipment was purchased through the design coordinator of the project, Play By Design of Ithaca, NY. When the Dream Playground is built by volunteers in Summer 2021, it will include many new and exciting features, such as a zipline, high-climbing equipment, castles, a treehouse, a soft but seamless rubber play surface, composite materials, instruments, and educational and inclusive play elements.

The original Dream Playground is being dismantled this winter to make way for the new facility, which will be constructed in mid-2021 as a community volunteer build project. The original playground was built over six days in August 2002, and was one of the largest volunteer projects Port Angeles has ever seen.

The Dream Playground Foundation will continue to fundraise for this project through Summer 2021. Customized, engraved pickets and bricks are currently available for purchase, and larger components are available for

sponsorship by businesses, families, and foundations. These sales will raise money for the rebuild, and the pickets and bricks will be placed throughout the new playground.
